

Still No Identity On Slain Girl

Sheriff's detectives continued efforts today to identify the young girl whose nude body was found Friday in Mark West Creek.

Several phone calls were checked out by officers, but nothing definite had been established this morning.

The victim's upper teeth were false and she had a gold crown on the lower right side of her mouth, which officers hope will assist them to identify her as soon as possible.

She is described as 18 to 25 years of age, possibly of Mexican-American decent, five feet five to seven inches, 125 pounds, with long dark hair brown eyes and both ears pierced.

Her nude body was found hog-tied in Mark West Creek, near where the remains of three oth-

er girls were found in Franz Valley within the past two years.

The pathologist who performed an autopsy Saturday said preliminary information indicated she was strangled to death.

Sheriff Don Striepeke asked that anyone with information about any young missing girl matching the description of the victim to call his office immediately.

A \$1,000 reward has also been offered through the Secret Witness program for information leading to the arrest and conviction of the person or persons responsible for her death.

Anyone sending leads to the Secret Witness will not be identified to law enforcement officials.
